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Having anywhere from one to four hours of screen time per day at age 1 is linked with higher risks of developmental delays in communication, fine motor, problemsolving and personal and social skills by age 2, according to a study of 7,097 children published Monday in the journal JAMA Pediatrics.

"The study fills an important gap because it identifies specific developmental delays (in skills) such as communication and problem-solving associated with screen time," said Nagata, noting there haven't been many prior studies that studied this issue with several years of follow-up data.

The study measured how many hours children used screens per day at age 1 and how they performed in several developmental domains communication skills, fine motor skills, personal and social skills, and problemsolving skills — at ages 2 and 4. Both measures were according to the mothers' self-reports. By age 2, those who had had up to four hours of screen time per day were up to three times more likely to experience developmental delays in communication and problem-solving skills.

Those who had spent four or more hours with screens were 4.78 times more likely to have underdeveloped communication skills, 1.74 times more likely to have subpar fine motor skills and two times more likely to have underdeveloped personal and social skills by age 2. By age 4, risk remained only in the communication and problem–solving categories.
